Thank you for your interest in training with us. We take pride in what we do and truly enjoy helping people and their pets become closer and better family members. Here are some things to know about our classes and how to enroll. Please read carefully.

- 1. A six week class is \$175.00 (cash is preferred over checks. If you bring cash to the first night of class, we will return your check and deduct \$10, so class will cost \$165). To hold your place in the Wednesday June 15th class, please send a check made out to Patricia Terrio, along with your completed registration form and the hold-harmless agreement. Please address the envelope to Patty Terrio at 12675 Whalen Lake Dr, Hartland MI 48353. In the memo line, put your phone number, pets name and date that class begins. You may date the check for the first night of class, but there will be no refunds after we receive the check. Your check signifies a contract with us and we will be holding a spot for you. Let me know by phone or email if you decide that you want to enroll and we will look for your check in the mail. Enrollment will be first-come first-served, in order of checks received, and we cannot guarantee a spot. If we receive your check and the class is full, we will return it.
- 2. Classes for this June session will be held on Wednesday_nights at 6:00 pm and run approximately one hour at 12675 Whalen Lake Dr., Hartland, Mi., the last house on private drive, through black gates. If google maps sends you down a dirt road, you are too far north on Fenton Rd. On the first night, please come at 5:45pm and leave your dog in car and come to the check-in table to check in. We will give you additional directions after you arrive.
- 3. First night of class you will need to bring proof that your pet has had a negative fecal test within the last 4 months and proof that your dog is current on all vaccinations. Puppies need at least 2 distemper/Parvo shots before they are allowed in class. Bordetella and flu vaccines are not required at this time.
- 4. You will also need to bring lots of small chewy training treats and very hungry dog. We also recommend a tug toy or interactive toy. Snug collar is a must as class will be outside in an area that is not completely fenced in. Personal lawn chairs should be brought to class each week. Please dress for weather. Inside area is available in case of bad weather. Lots of shade trees available for spectators to sit under. Water and bowls for your pet and water for yourself is recommended. Sun may be hot at times, so cool / wet towel for pet/you and hat is also recommended. Kneeling matt for you is recommended in case grass is wet. Bug spray is also recommended for you and your pet.
- 5. Please clean up after you pet.
- 6. Comfortable shoes are a must. No flip flops, crocks, open toe shoes, high heels, etc. This class will primarily be conducted outside on grass. If recent rain, rubber shoes are

- recommended. You may also be asked to kneel/sit on grass with your pet. You are welcome to bring a mat or towel to kneel on.
- 7. Parking is in front of the barn, under trees near barn or along the driveway. Try to stay on black top and off of grass when parking on driveway. You may park near the house as well -- leave enough room for cars to pass on the driveway side. Parking will be permitted on grass surrounding obedience rings if grass is not wet. Please ask or use common sense. Do not park outside of the gates, that is not my property.
- 8. Please bring whatever leash and collar you are currently using. We will go over required equipment first night. We do sell some leashes and collars for your convenience. We do not allow <u>flexies</u> for leashes during class, but they can/will be used to help teach your dog to come. Also, dogs that weigh over 10 lbs. will be required to have a leather leash by the second night.
- 9. Cell phone coverage is ok in the area.
- 10. There is no restroom at the barn, so please plan accordingly. Long walk to house.
- 11. Spectators are welcome, but children/spectators must stay near training area at all times as there is a lake nearby.
- 12. In case of inclement weather or rain, we will have class at Rural King in Hartland, at corner of m-59 and Blaine, near us23. Decision will be made by 5:00 pm the day of class.
- 13. No class will be held on July 6th.
